

Ducky Pattern (no-sew)

Abbreviations:

FO = fasten off

ch = chain

sl st = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

inc = increase (insert 2 sc in same st)

dec = decrease (sc 2 sts together)

BLO = back loops only

FLO = front loops only

Difficulty:

Beginner

Head/Body:

R1: ch 2, 8 sc in 2nd chain from hook (8)

R2: inc around (16)

R3: (sc, inc) x8 (24)

R4-7: sc around (24)

R8: Dec around (12)

R9: inc around (24)

R10: sc 22, inc 2 (26)

R11: sc 23, inc 2, sc (28)

R12: sc 24, inc 2, sc 2 (30)

R13: sc 25, inc 2, sc 3 (32)

R14: sc around (32)

Materials:

Super bulky "6" yarn in desired color

10mm plastic safety eyes (x2)

4mm crochet hook

Stuffing

Yarn needle

Scissors

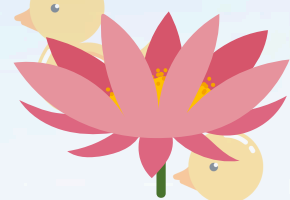
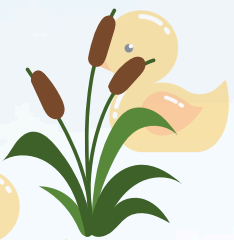
Stitch marker

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Beak:

The beak takes up 4 sts of space between R5-6

Fold body and head in half to find the middle where the beak should go

Insert hook and pull yarn through

R1: ch, sc 2, sl st

R2: Turn, sk a st, sc 2, sl st in last st. FO and weave in the ends

Eyes:

count 2 sts from the side of the beak and attach 9mm eyes

Continue body:

R15: (sc, dec) x2, sc 10, (dec,sc)x3, Dec 2, sc, Dec (24)

Stuff the head and body

R16: (sc, Dec)x8 (16)

R17: Dec around (8) FO and close hole

Wings:

The wings take up 4 sts of space between R10-11

Insert hook and pull yarn through

R1: ch 2, dc in same st as ch, dc in each of the next 3 sts

R2: ch, turn, sk a st, sc in next st, sc, sl st
