

# Fancy Chicken Pattern

## (Low-sew Hei Hei)

**Difficulty:**  
Beginner

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### Materials:

Super bulky "6" yarn in desired color  
Worsted weight 4 yarn for eyes (white)  
8mm plastic safety eyes (x2)  
4mm crochet hook  
Stuffing  
Yarn needle  
Scissors  
Stitch marker

### Abbreviations:

FO = fasten off  
ch = chain  
sl st = slip stitch  
sc = single crochet  
inc = increase (insert 2 sc in same st)  
dec = decrease (sc 2 sts together)  
BLO = back loops only  
FLO = front loops only



## Head/body:

Start in red

R1: ch 2, 8 sc in 2nd chain from hook (8)

R2: inc around (16)

R3: (sc, inc) x8 (24)

R4-7: sc around (24)

R8: CC to orange Dec around (12)

R9: sc 12 (12)

R10: inc around (24)

R11: sc 22, inc 2 (26)

R12: CC to teal sc 23, inc 2, sc (28)

R13: sc 24, inc 2, sc 2 (30)

R14: sc 25, inc 2, sc 3 (32)

R15: sc around (32)



## Beak:

The beak takes up 4 sts of space between R5-6

Fold body and head in half to find the middle where the beak should go

Insert hook and pull yarn through

R1: ch, sc 2, sl st

R2: ch 1, Turn, sk a st, sc 2, sl st in last st. FO and weave in the ends

## Continue Body:

R16: (sc, dec) x2, sc 10, (dec,sc)x3, Dec 2, sc, Dec (24)

Stuff the head and body

R17: (sc, Dec)x8 (16)

R18: Dec around (8) FO and close hole

## Wings:

The wings take up 4 sts of space between R10-11

Insert hook and pull yarn through

R1: ch 2, dc in same st as ch, dc in each of the next 3 sts

R2: ch, turn, sk a st, sc in next st, sc, sl st



## Legs:

Attach yarn between R16 and 17

Ch 13, sl st 3, ch 4, sl st 3, ch 4, sl st 3, sl st down the remainder of the ch, sl st in the same st where the ch was started.

FO and cut yarn

Repeat this for second leg about 2 sts apart from the first leg.



## Tail:

Between R13 and 14

sl st, ch 5, sl st down chain, sl st, ch 6, sl st down the ch, sl st, ch 5, sl st down the ch.

FO and cut yarn.



## Comb:

Ch 8,  
3rd ch from the hook tri, dc, HDC, sc, sl st down the ch.  
FO with a very long tail for sewing and details.  
Sew the comb in the middle of the head.  
With the leftover long tail, add the details around the beak using a tapestry needle.

## Details around beak:

Using the yarn tail from the comb, insert your needle one stitch next to the beak and come out the stitch that is the corner of the beak. Pull the yarn until it is the desired length for the hanging part.  
Then pull the yarn over the beak and insert one stitch away from the beak again, exiting right at the corner of the beak. Pull yarn to match the same as the other side of the beak.  
With the remaining yarn tail, go back through the head and I sew down the comb one more time before cutting the yarn!

## Eyes:

Make 2  
R1: sc 6 in MC (6)  
R2: inc around (12)  
R3-4: sc 12 (12)  
FO leaving long tail for sewing.  
Place safety eyes between R1 and 2 of the eyes.  
Sew eyes between R2 and 5 of the head and stuff as you sew the eyes on.
